Lincoln County, Hugo, Colorado

- Nearest rape crisis center is in Denver
- No confidential victim advocacy services available



Challenge: Large service area with several corrections facilities



Kern County, California

- Huge service area with a combination of rural and semi-urban communities
- Prisons, jails, lockups, military detention, and youth facilities
- One-stop shop for women's and survivors' services



Challenge: No Community Response Teams

Barnwell County, Barnwell, South Carolina

- Rape crisis center serves many communities
- No forensic examiners and no sexual assault response team


Trinity County, Weaverville, California


- Limited resources

- · No organized SART




